

ACCESS GUIDE

The Donmar Warehouse aims to be accessible and welcoming to everyone.

Below is all the information you should need ahead of your visit. If you have any questions, please call the box office on 020 3282 3808 or email access@donmarwarehouse.com.

Blue Badge parking

There is one Blue Badge parking bay outside the Donmar, which is available after 6.30pm. For more information about parking spaces close to the theatre, call Camden Council on 020 7974 4444 or visit camden.gov.uk.

Entering the theatre

There is a 15cm step up from the pavement into the foyer. We have a portable ramp. If you would like to use it, please ask a member of staff.

Foyer and box office

The box office is located on the left-hand side as you enter the foyer. The main box office counter is approximately 1.2m high but there is a lower-level counter at the far end.

The stairs up to the theatre are located on the right-hand side of the foyer and the lift is located at the back of the building. The lift gives you access to both the stalls and circle levels.

The staircase leads up to both the stalls and circle. There are handrails on both sides and the treads are clearly highlighted. There are 26 steps from the foyer to the stalls and another 23 from the stalls to the circle.

Bar

There are bars on all three levels of the building. They open one hour before the performance.

Loos

There are ladies and gentlemen's loos on the stalls level, up three steps. There is an accessible loo on the circle level.

Auditorium

The auditorium seats 251 people. The seating is bench-seating and surrounds three sides of a wide rectangular stage.

The stalls entrance on the first floor brings you into a sloping, dimly-lit passage that runs behind the seats. An usher will be located in the doorway to direct you to your seat. There are two steps down to rows A and B, and one step up to row D. There are no steps to row C.

The circle entrance leads you straight into the back of the auditorium. There are steps to all seats.
